Athletics

Salem County Christian Academy maintains an active interscholastic sports program. We are members of Delaware Valley Christian Athletic Conference (DVCAC). We are proud of the testimony and reputation that our athletic teams have built over the years and endeavor to set the standard for others. Our athletes are afforded a place of honor, and thus we expect them to conduct themselves always in an exemplary manner. All students attending athletic events, whether home or away, are expected to maintain our school conduct code.
