

## 2019-2020 TUITION AND FEES

➤ **REGISTRATION FEE**

**\$200 for new students to the Academy.**

- **All material costs are included in the tuition rates. 10% of your annual tuition rate is due by July 1 unless you pay in full or choose the 12-month plan (which your first tuition payment would be due in July). Sports fees and part-time student fees are not included in these tuition rates.**

**TUITION RATES FOR 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR**

- ◆ The **Tuition Rates** for **2019-2020** school year are:

- Pre-school (PreK-3) \$6120 per year
- ½ day (PreK-3) \$3520 per year
- ½ day PreK-4-Kindergarten \$3675 per year
- PreK4 to Kindergarten \$6270 per year
- Elementary (1-6) \$6680 per year
- Junior/Senior High School \$6885 per year

➤ **HOME SCHOOL and ADDITIONAL CLASS TUITION RATES**

- ◆ \$850 per course (this includes textbooks and materials)

➤ **FAMILY TUITION RATES**

- **1<sup>st</sup> child in the Academy = pay 100% of tuition**
- **2<sup>nd</sup> child in the Academy = pay 85% of tuition**
- **3<sup>rd</sup> and all subsequent children = pay 70% of tuition**

**Please note: SALEM COUNTY CHRISTIAN ACADEMY plans its budget on “anticipated” enrollment. No refunds and/or adjustments will be made on tuition when a child is not in attendance (sick days, snow days, vacations, etc.)**

➤ **TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS**

- ◆ **Plan A** Full amount of tuition due by July 1 (\$200 per student discount)
- ◆ **Plan B** ½ of tuition paid in August and the remainder in January 2020
- ◆ **Plan C** 10% of total tuition by July 1, remainder divided into 10-monthly payments (**Aug-May**)
- ◆ **Plan D** 12-month payment plan (**July-June**)

➤ **Volunteer Incentive Program (VIP)**

Each SCC Academy family is required to serve at least 10 hours in an approved volunteer project or opt to pay a fee of \$250. Some examples of approved volunteer projects would include: concessions for games, general maintenance, serving at the Thanksgiving Dinner, Race for Education, Golf Tournament, etc. There is a section included on application for each family to indicate their decision either to be involved in the VIP program or to *opt out* and pay the \$250 (options are available to pay, see the application sheet).

➤ **EXTENDED CARE**

<i>Morning</i>	<b>7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.</b>	<b>(K3-12)</b>
<i>Afternoon</i>	<b>3:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m.</b>	<b>(K3-12)</b>

- ◆ Extended Care will be figured/and billed on an hourly basis.
- ◆ The cost is **\$7 per hour, or \$4 for every ½ hour or portion thereof.**
- ◆ Extended Care is only in session when school is open.
- ◆ There will be Extended Care on scheduled half-days but not on cancellations, delays or early dismissals that are due to inclement weather.
- ◆ Students must be **signed out** of Extended Care by a parent/guardian.
- ◆ All students who are in Extended Care must be registered (Please obtain a form from the office)
- ◆ There will not be extended care during scheduled Parent/Teacher conferences

If enrolling after school has started and parents want 2 payments, tuition will be prorated then ½ the tuition payment is due at enrollment, and the remaining ½ is due January 1.

➤ **TUITION POLICIES**

1. All tuition payments are due on the date that you select from the FACTS tuition application. A **ten-day** grace period is given before accounts are considered **past due**.
2. Tuition payments are considered **past due** if not paid within 10 days of the due date. A **\$35** late fee will be applied for payments **not received** within 10 days of the due date. A reminder will be sent on the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the due date, if tuition payment has not been **received**.
3. Students **may not be allowed to return to class** for accounts that are more than 30 days past due unless arrangements have been made.
4. A \$35 fee will be assessed for all returned checks/insufficient funds. **If a check or account is reported for insufficient funds Salem County Christian Academy will no longer accept checks.** Payment must be made by cash, money order, or cashier's check from that date forward.
5. **Transcripts, report cards, diplomas, or school records cannot be released until accounts are current. Students may not take final exams or participate in commencement if accounts are not current.**
6. Tuition charges of a student withdrawn will be prorated on the basis of the number of months or fractions thereof that the student attends the school. **A 10% processing fee of the yearly tuition per child will be charged for withdrawal. Allow 60 days for refunds to be processed.**
7. Tuition charges for a child admitted to the school during either semester will be prorated.

**WAYS TO HELP PAY FOR A CHRISTIAN EDUCATION**

➤ **STUDENT RECRUITMENT AWARDS**

This program is designed to encourage people who have a heart to see Christian education grow in South Jersey and more specifically at Salem County Christian Academy. A \$300 monetary recruitment award will be given to any person who recommends a new student family to the Academy and they enroll, are accepted, **and attend for at least 2 semesters.**

To ensure the Academy disburses your award, be sure to have the incoming student family let administration know when enrolling that they have been recommended by you.
